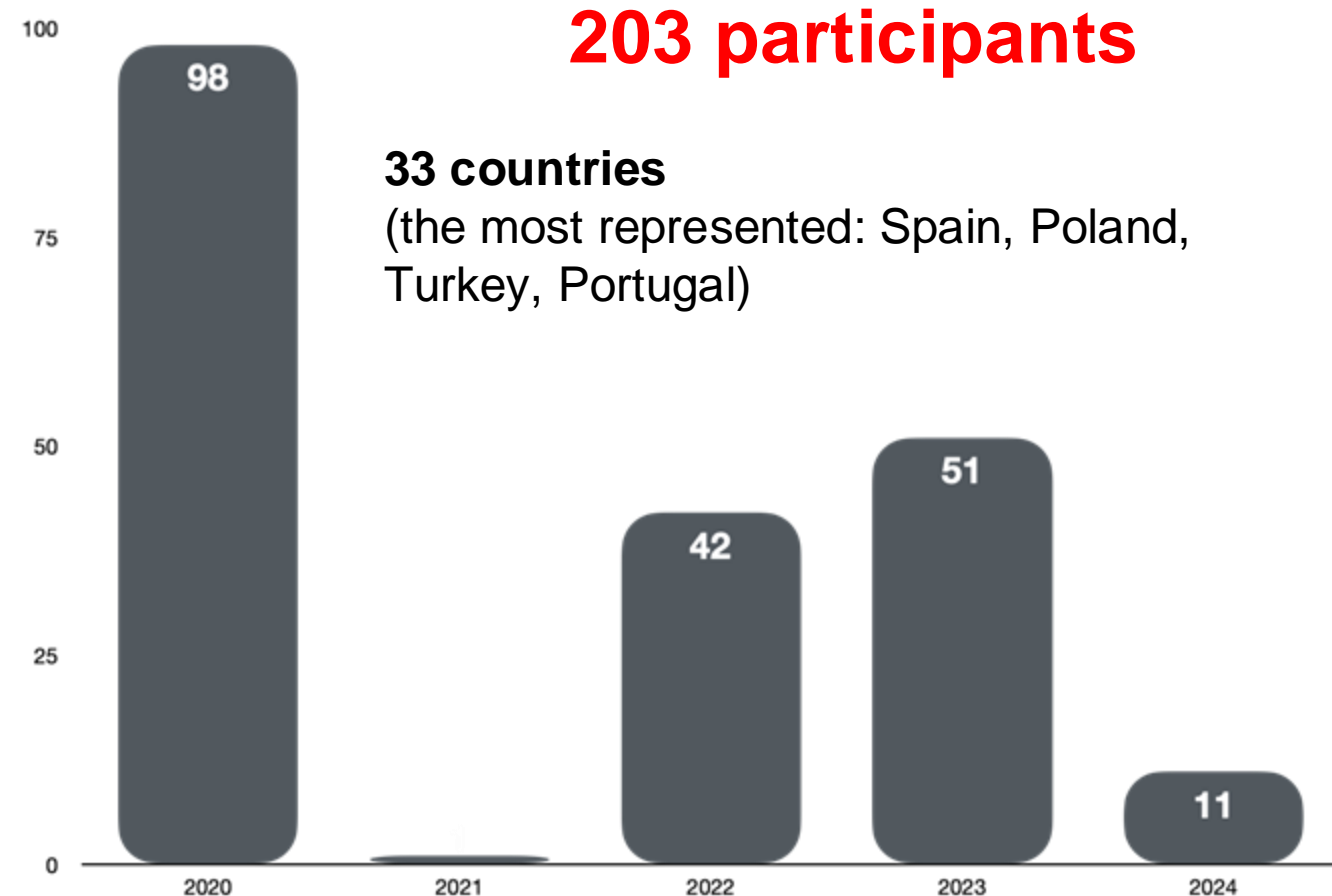

LEAD-ME started during COVID pandemic with online activities only

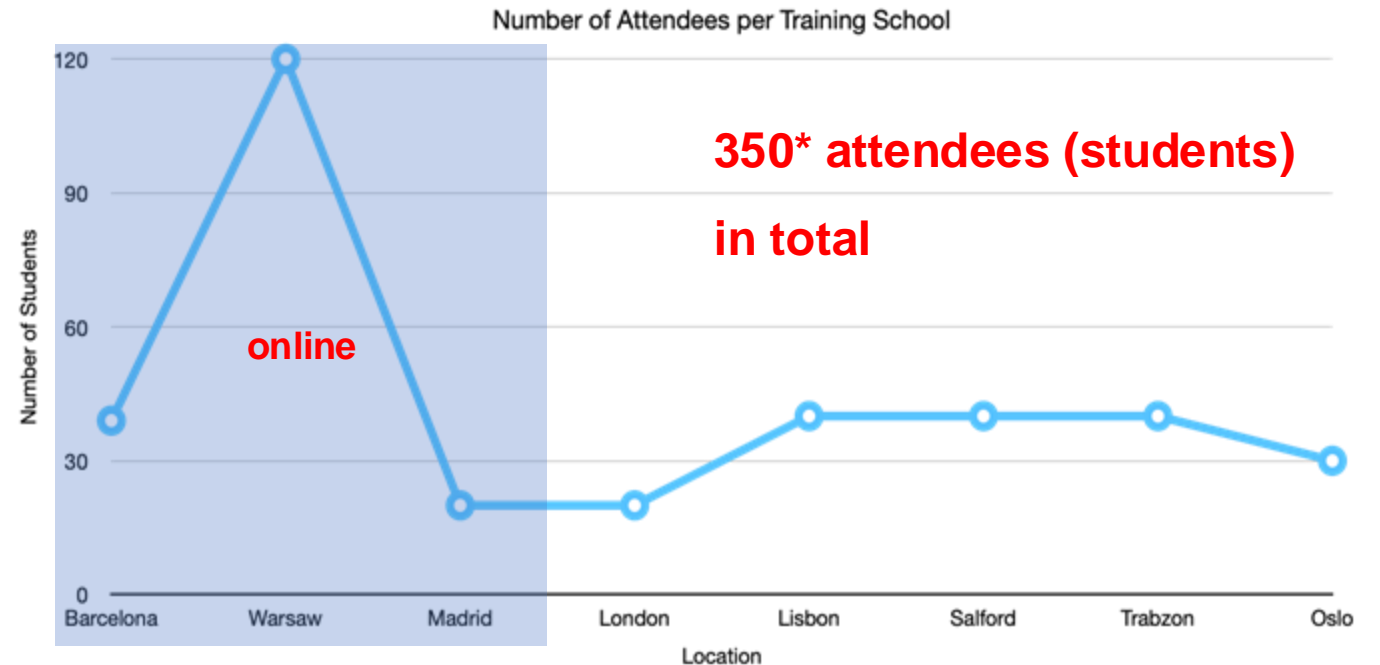
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Now, in 4th GP there is one networking activity each month offered to LEAD-ME participants

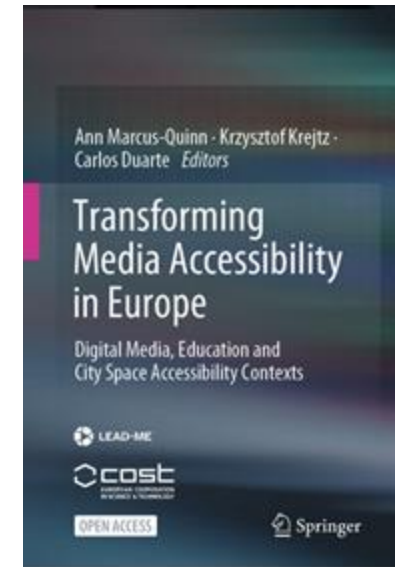
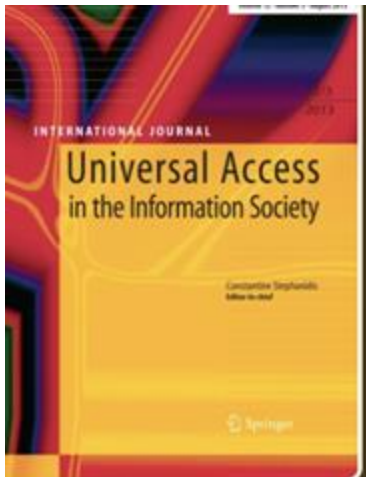


